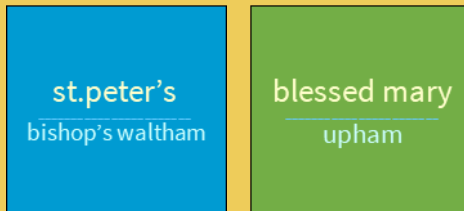


St Peter's and Blessed Mary Churches Sunday May 4th 2025

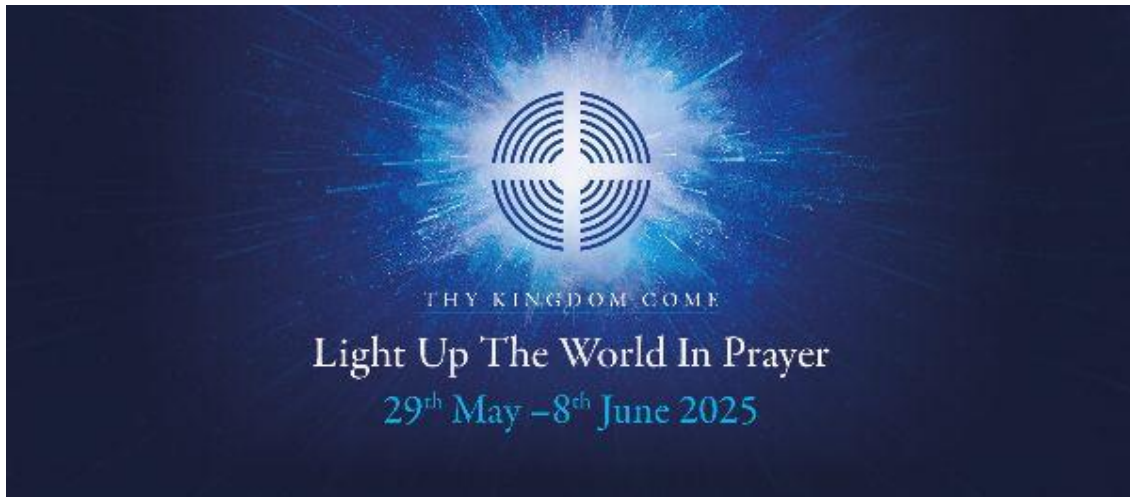
This Team not only welcomes people into our Church for the 10.30 Service, but hopefully sends people out from the 9am Service, on their way with a smile!

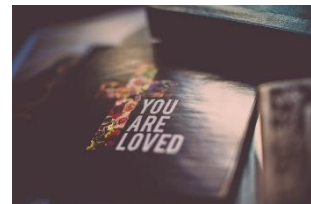
