

God and Creation Saturday 17th January - St Peter and St Paul's Hambledon

St Peter and St Paul's Hambledon is hosting a discussion on God and Creation on Saturday 17 January at 4pm.

The very Reverend David Fergusson OBE is Regis Professor of Divinity at the University of Cambridge will give a talk, which will be followed by a Q and A session. Professor Fergusson has had a long academic career, as well as serving as parish minister earlier in his career. He was recently described as 'the most distinguished theologian in Britain", and his talk is sure to be thought provoking. In 2019 Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II appointed him as Dean of the Chapel Royal in Scotland and Dean of the Order of the Thistle, both of which he still holds. Professor Fergusson wil join us for our Service on Sunday 18 January at 1100. The event is free and is part of the 150th anniversary celebration of the huge refurbishment of the Church in 1876 and our role as a Silver Eco Church.
