The Invitation to Communion

Jesus is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world.

If you would like personal prayer, for yourself or someone else, please speak with the leader of the service afterwards.

Please sing or keep a prayerful silence during the giving of communion.

After Communion, a Post-Communion Prayer, then:

Faithful God, in baptism you have adopted us as your children, made us members of the body of Christ and chosen us as inheritors of your kingdom: we thank you that in this Communion you renew your promises within us, empower us by your Spirit to witness and to serve, and send us out as disciples of your Son Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

May Christ give you grace to grow in holiness, to deny yourselves, take up your cross, and follow him; and the blessing of God almighty, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, be among you and remain with you always. **Amen**
