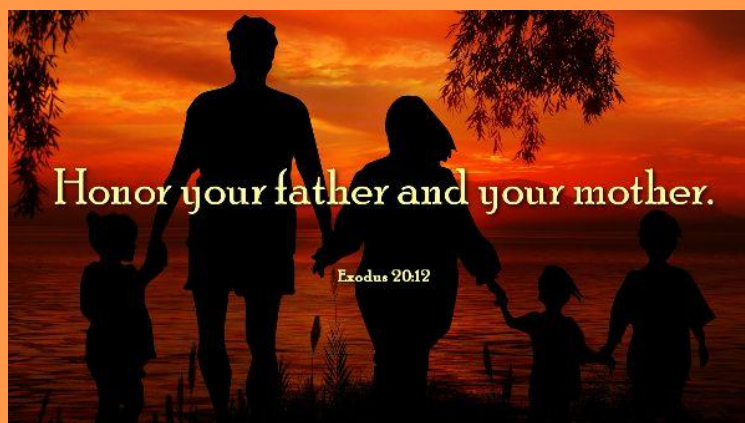

How does giving to God at St Peter's work?



Several of you, existing and new members, have recently been asking how you might give to St Peter's?

For those who are new, it is always lovely when we are asked 'how might I give?' and then we are able to give you details.

If you have been around for a while, but have not asked us about giving yet, Paul Emmerson, chair of the Stewardship committee or others in the team, will approach at an appropriate moment and ask if you might want to give and how? Or even better you could approach him!

When it comes to giving, our recommended way is through the **Parish Giving Scheme (PGS)** which not only saves our Treasurer a lot of work (we have 90+ people in the PGS) but also ensures that we receive the Gift Aid element (where appropriate) on a monthly basis which helps our cash flow as well.

With PGS, you set up a Direct Debit and you can do this by telephoning them on 0333 002 1271 (lines open between 9.00 am and 5.00 pm Monday to Friday), quoting St Peter's Parish Code 290629026.

However, if you prefer to give by Standing Order/Regular Payment to the Parochial Church Council rather than via the PGS then the bank details you require are as follows:

The amount that you are called to give is of course personal, but the most important aspect is the commitment to give a sum on a regular basis as this enables us to plan our future expenditure with confidence when setting the Church budget.

All the information about your giving is treated in the strictest confidence.
