

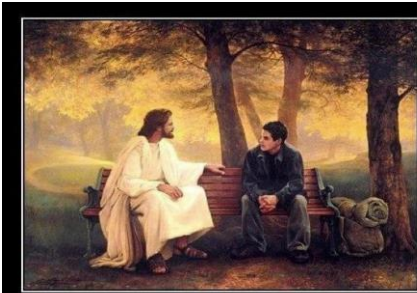
ST PETER'S MISSION ACTION PLAN 2015-2020

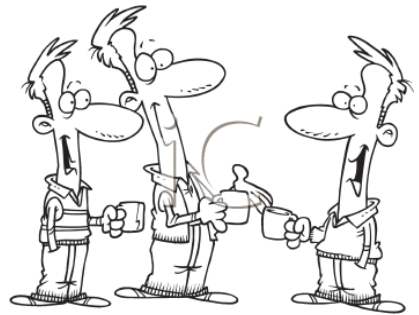

CONFIDENT DISCIPLES – to put into practice what will encourage us to be 'disciples who make disciples'. For example, through mentoring and small group membership with a focus around: prayer, scripture and The Gospel.

Ongoing; Cost £0

CONFIDENT WITNESSES – to be more of a 'go to others' as well as a 'come to us' church. For example, to provide 'stepping stones' to faith through our friendships, invitation and hospitality.

Ongoing; Cost £0



TRAINING – to provide support for congregation members and for leaders with special responsibilities or roles e.g., internal, external or joint courses.

2016 Onwards; Cost £1000pa



LEADERSHIP STRUCTURE – to

put in place a team of leaders in key areas, for our size of church. This is to enable more effective leadership, oversight and lines of communication.

Jul-Dec 2015; Cost £0



SUPPORTED LEADERS – to

appoint leaders (financially supported) where there is not sufficient voluntary time to give continuity. For example, in youth work, office assistance and informal music.

Jul-Dec 2015; Cost £20,000pa

COMMUNICATION - to

improve our communication both externally and internally. For example, through more 'one to one' communication, but also the use of digital means such as the website, social media and databases.

Jun-Dec 2015; Cost £1000



PROPERTY – to plan, in light of our ministry/mission needs, for phased projects which will make our church space more flexible for worship and other uses.

Phase 2: circulation area, chapel for smaller services, lighting and audio/visual.

2016-17; Cost £50-£100,000

Phase 3: layout, floor and seating.

2017-20; Cost £500,000

Phase 1 was the new welcome porch and doors.
