WHAT'S ON

Home Groups - Joining one of our home groups is a great opportunity to deepen faith and to give and receive friendship. They usually meet twice a month to study the Bible, to pray, to chat and to relax together!



Exploring Christianity - We hold courses such as Alpha, Christianity Explored, parenting, marriage preparation and baptism/confirmation preparation. You would be welcome to find out more.



Prayer - There is no more important thing in our lives than to spend time being and communicating with God. As well as prayer in services, we would love you to join with all the other opportunities:



- daily personal prayer:** Bible notes available
- morning prayer:** week days at 8:45am
- individual prayer:** members of our prayer team are available at our main services
- prayer requests:** can be made through the church office or via the box in church
- prayer meetings:** we have periodic special times of prayer together, e.g. 24/7 prayer and various prayer events.

Music - Music is an important part of our Church family life. You don't have to be a professional, but just be willing to join in: Adult Choir, Junior Choir, Worship Band and Bell Ringing.
