The Country Fayre Committee would like to thank everybody who supported us to make this year's Fayre yet another great occasion.

#### **Some numbers...**

2,500 programmes delivered by hand, 28 advertisers, 2 sponsors, 1500+ people attended, 40+ stall holders, 600+ emails, 6 meetings, 50+ phone calls, 160 pints of beer, 100 glasses of PIMMS, 100 glasses of lemonade, 30 bottles of Prosecco (sold out), countless hotdogs, burgers, and bacon butties, 700 cups of tea/coffee/cold drinks, 95 sandwiches, 26 people made cakes, traybakes and biscuits, 8 pavlovas (all food sold out), 20 Competitors for the baking competition, 120 ice creams, 230 bottles on the bottle stall, 55 tables and 110 chairs moved (twice), 20 straw bales, 4 trips with the maypole, 7 hours of sunshine, 30 coconuts bought, 60 + trips up the tower, 6 racing pigs, 8 ferrets racing, 60 dogs in the dog show, 6 classic cars, over 1,200 raffle tickets sold with 15 prizes and an undisclosed number of grey hairs and aching muscles!
