Your 'Good Deeds Jar'

You will need the following things:

- An empty glass jar
- Something to decorate your jar (e.g. tissue paper, wrapping paper, stickers, paint)
- Some string of something to hang your jar with
- A copy of our 'Good Deeds' sheet printed out

Instructions:

- First decorate your jar in whatever way you'd like to.
- Then tie some string around it in a way that it won't slip off (you may need to tape it in place and do check its secure by asking a grown-up).
- Then cut out the good deeds from the sheet.
- Write some of your own good deeds if you'd like to.
- Roll or fold them all up individually and put them into your jar.
- Place or hang your completed jar somewhere you will see it.
- Everyday you can pull out one good deed and try to do it that day.
