"The most important one," answered Jesus, "is this:...Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength. The second is this: Love your neighbour as yourself. There is no commandment greater than these."

My 'Love Your Neighbour' Street

You will need the following things:

- A4 paper (or larger if you have it)
- Pens / crayons to decorate

Instructions:

- 1) Fold your paper backwards and forwards into a concertina so you have 5 equal folded areas and keep it folded.
- 2) Cut the paper to the size you would like your houses to be.
- 3) Cut the shape of a roof through all of the folded parts.
- 4) Open out and you have your concertina houses in a row.
- 5) Decorate the houses by colouring them and adding windows and doors.
- 6) Write on each house how we can be a good neighbour: show forgiveness / pray / give / help / share.
- 7) You can add to your street by asking a grown up to help you make concertina people or by decorating a flat piece of paper to display your street (maybe you could draw on a road or gardens and make trees to stand up).
- 8) Display your concertina street to remind you of the ways you can show love to the people around
