One of my favourite verses in the bible is about love and it is from the book of Corinthians. It describes what love is.

"Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It does not dishonour others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. Love never fails."

1 Corinthians 13: 4-8

Infact, Jesus is love! We could change the word 'love' to Jesus in the verse above and it would still make sense! Try changing the word love to your name too! Does it describe you? If it doesn't maybe you could try to work on some of things you find hard to do to show love to others.



This week I thought you could either make a valentines card to Jesus or make a 'flower of love' with all the words that the verse above uses to describe love!

You could then give it, with a card, to someone who you love or just keep it for yourself.

My Flower of Love

You will need the following things:

- Card of different colours
- pipe cleaner
- Pens

Instructions:

- 1) Cut out a circle for the central part of the flower and write the word 'Love' on it.
- 2) Cut out petal shapes out of different colours of card and write on all the words that the verse uses to describe love e.g. patient, kind.
- 3) Stick the petals onto the central part of the flower.
- 4) Attach a pipe cleaner (for the stalk) to the back of the flower using Sellotape.
- 5) Put into a jar which you could decorate with a ribbon or in any other way that you like.
- 6) Give to someone to make them feel special or keep for yourself to remind you how Jesus loves you and how you can show love to others.
