My Basket

You will need the following things:

- A4 card / paper
- Pen
- Sellotape / stapler

Instructions:

You can make your basket anyway that you like but if you are not sure, why don't you make this simple one:

- Fold an A4 sheet of paper or card in half.
- Use sellotape to stick together the sides (or you could staple them together).
- Make a handle using another sheet of paper and attach to your basket.
- Write the words on your basket.
- You could make some pretend wheat from stripes of yellow paper and scatter them on the floor to collect if you liked! Or just keep some other treasures in your basket.
