- 1 The financial statements of the PCC have been prepared n accordance with Church Accounting Regulations 2006 using the Receipts & Payments basis.
- 2 Designated funds are: Project Fund (£31839), Hardship Fund (500), Flower Fund (£769), Music Fund (£159), Choir Fund (£200) Fabric Fund (£461), Bells (£155) & Organ (£10).
- 3 The Wardrop Fund consists of 157 units in the Church of England Fixed Interest Securities Fund held by the Diocese & valued at £257. This is a restricted Fund and is used in the maintenance of the churchyard.
- 4 The majority of the Fabric fund is held in the C of E Deposit account and shows a balance of £3527. This is the balance of accumulated donations and appeals for fabric maintenance, which can only be spent for that purpose
- 5 Organ Fund represents accumulated donations and appeals for maintenance of the organ and can only be spent for that purpose (£7,588). Similar for Bell Fund (£4,759)

## Independent examiner's report to the Parochial Church Council of The Blessed Mary Upham

This report on the financial statements of the PCC for the year ended 31 December 2020, which are set out on pages 1 to 4, is in respect of an examination carried out in accordance with the Church Accounting Regulations 2006 ("the Regulations") and s.43 of the Charities Act 1993 ("the Act").

## Respective responsibilities of the PCC and the examiner

As members of the PCC you are responsible for the preparation of the financial statements; you consider that the audit requirement of the Regulations and Section 43(2) of the Act does notapply. It is my responsibility to issue this report on those financial statements in accordance with the terms of the Regulations.

## Basis of this report

My examination was carried out in accordance with the General Directions given by the Charity Commission under section 43(7)(b) of the Act and to be found in the Church guidance, 2006 edition. That examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the PCC and a comparisonof the accounts with those records. It also includes considering any unusual items of disclosures in the financial statements and seeking explanations from you as trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts.
