## St Peter's - Sunday Services

On Sunday mornings (St Peter's) we are conscious that time is sometimes tight between our services (8am to 9am, 9am to 10:30am).

This means having to wait while a service finishes, those worshiping not being rushed or disturbed, some people needing to come in and go out, people 'coming in and going out' at the end and people needing to tidy up from the last service and some needing to get

ready for the next service! In summary, there is a lot of people to consider and a lot going on. Also on Sunday mornings we are also seeing more people around which is lovely, and so it can be a bit crowded!

In light of all this, may we mention a few things:

- 1.Please wait outside quietly until the service has finished so as not to inadvertently disturb the last parts of the 8am and 9am which are often quieter and noise is easily heard.
- 2. However, if you would like to go in to the end of the 8am or 9am you are very welcome.... because it is raining or you would like to join in the worship to receive communion or sing the last hymn. Please go into a back pew or under the gallery.
- 3.Overall, every service is a time for us to be able to focus our time in worship of God, but also an opportunity to welcome all who come in, whether from the next congregation, or the new person for the first time, so please do look out for them.

#### St Peter's - South and North Aisle Areas

As you will be aware, agreement has been given to improving and enhancing the family and children's area in the North aisle and enlarging the area for choir and musical related-activities in the South aisle, which necessitates the removal of the remaining pews in both aisles.



It is planned to remove the pews on Fri 23 Feb/ Sat 24 Feb and we are hopeful that most of the pews will be sold with the proceeds going towards the overall costs of this project, including furnishings for the North aisle as well as additional chairs for use in both aisles as and when necessary. The cost of implementing the proposals will come from existing legacy monies.

Discussions continue in respect of the final layout of the enhanced facilities in the North aisle, but specific provision will be made for children and young people as well as for an improved milling area for fellowship and refreshments between the Services on a Sunday.

The new chairs will be ordered once we have been through a selection process and will complement the existing décor in the Church. The delivery time is not known yet, but if delivery of the new chairs is unduly delayed, then we will borrow chairs from the Hall & Stables if required. Carpet will be fitted in both aisles, again to complement the existing décor in the Church, and the type of carpet has been agreed with a view to fitting as soon as possible after the pews have been removed.
