
# St Peter's and Blessed Mary 24th March 2024 - Palm Sunday

As you will probably be aware, the pews in the North and South aisles have been removed and a big thank you to the Men's Shed and members of our own congregation who helped with this task. Remedial work is being undertaken on the panelling and again thanks are due to the Men's Shed. A good number of pews have been sold and thanks to David (Williamson) for managing this. Carpets were fitted in the North and South aisles earlier this week and the opportunity was taken to replace the carpets under the gallery and in the corridor leading to the toilets so that all carpets in the Church match. The next stage is to order additional chairs and a final decision on style and colour will be made by the PCC at its meeting on 26 March. Likewise, the final layouts in the North aisle and South aisle have yet to be determined so please bear with us as we consider how best to maximise the use of these areas, in particular in relation to use by Kate for families, children and youth activities etc. Just a reminder that it was agreed by the PCC at the outset that all the costs relating to the reordering are to be met from Legacy monies so will have no impact on the day-to-day finances of the Church


